When and where does each choir rehearse?

Rehearsals are held on Mondays during the school year at Chatham United Methodist Church (460 Main Street, Chatham, NJ) as follows:

Camerata	Monday 6:15-8:15pm
Sola Voce	Monday 4:15-6:00pm
Coro Vivo	Monday 4:15-6:00pm
Primo Coro	Monday 4:30-6:00pm

What type of performances does NJYC give?

Annual concerts are held during the winter holiday season and in the spring. The Chorus also performs with professional orchestras and choirs, for regional and national music conferences, for a variety of community and corporate functions, and in collaboration with other performance organizations. We perform in NJ, in neighboring states, across the US, and internationally.

What is Kids for Kids?

As part of NJYC's *Kids for Kids* initiative, our choirs perform to raise funds and awareness for children's organizations and charities. Each ensemble participates in at least one *Kids for Kids* performance every season. What are the tuition rates?

Primi Passi is a non-auditioned choral music experience for boys and girls in 3rd grade. It is a wonderful way for children to explore their interest in music and singing, and may be a gateway to other opportunities in the *New Jersey Youth Chorus*. Primi Passi meets for 8 weeks in the spring, on Tuesdays from 4:30-5:30pm. Tuition for the session is \$165.
