BRENNA MORAN

How long have you been with NJYC?

I joined New Jersey Youth Chorus in fourth grade, and have been singing with them ever since. This is now my ninth year in the choir.

What is the best thing about being in it?

The best thing about being in NJYC is having the opportunity to create genuine connections through music. When I sing with the choir, I know that I am surrounded by people whose love of music is genuine and sincere. Our time spent rehearsing new music together allows us to explore the complex, emotional meanings behind what others may perceive simply as notes on a paper. We are able to connect through every mistake made and consequent lesson learned, every challenge tackled and new intention discovered. When we perform, we are able to share the love we have found for every piece with an audience, as we experience the profound effect music can have on those whom it impacts. I am so grateful to have been able to create beautiful music and memories with my choir sisters, and to know that our passion for song has brought joy to others.

What is your favorite memory of NJYC?

I won't deny that my memories of singing at the Superbowl, Lincoln Center, ACDA, and numerous other extraordinary performances are amazing, and I will hold them with me forever. However, my favorite memories of NJYC are not associated with specific performances, but the feelings that came from them. I can not describe the emotion that comes with hearing the final chords of Psalm 23 and squeezing a friend's hand as Mrs. Joyce smiles with gratitude and pride. Or the feeling of seeing an audience member mouth the words to a song as tears fall from their eyes. I can not describe the love I feel when music expresses what words can not. All I know is that these memories prove to me that music is my passion, and remind me of the bonds it has allowed me to form.

Do you plan to continue singing after you graduate?

Yesssssss :) I plan to continue to learn and perform new music, and eventually major in vocal performance.

Anything else you'd like to say?

I am so grateful to be a member of New Jersey Youth Chorus. Without it, I would not have met all the beautiful and amazing people in the choir whom I now call my friends. I would not have had the opportunity and privilege to be able to sing at countless performances,

travel to new places, and work with incredible musicians. I would not have been able to connect with audiences from around the world. And I would not have made the innumerable memories I have today, which continue to motivate me to sing. Even though I am sad to graduate, I know it will always stay with me, and that the people I have met will always hold a place in my heart.
